We look forward to welcoming everyone back for another great term!

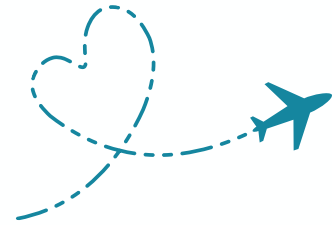
Our **Connect Group Leaders and Door Hosts Team Meeting** is on this Sunday, **5 July** after morning tea.

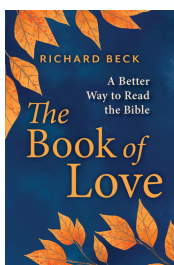

Thinking about Baptism?

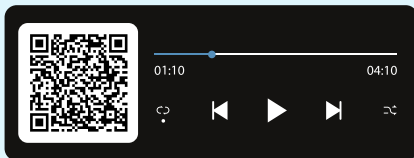

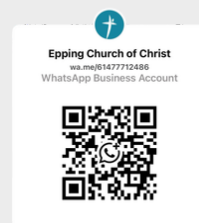

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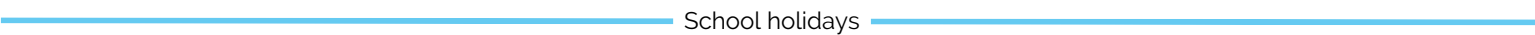
