



Twelve 'guys n girls' from Queensland churches and Epping have finally completed the transformation of a neighbouring residential property into a commercial venture to help fund the ever increasing running costs of Medical Santo. (Core building works were completed earlier this year by several work teams and volunteers).

Bedrooms with kids 'graffiti' became smart offices. Floors were tiled, internal fixings replaced. Bathrooms created, kitchenette rebuilt and a clean paint job inside and out left not much wanting.

Finally a new septic system dug deep into the ground by local Ni-van staff and a security fence and gates provided some practical necessities and kept the team very busy.

A small shower room was modified to allow wheelchair access and new tiles laid.

Jono got to make some head way on the dental chair, however due to the high calcium levels on the Vanuatu water, it was deemed too challenging to make all the dental attachments work. So they will be removed and it will be used solely as a dental chair without the accessories.


A visiting volunteer dentist had great success with a mobile dental tool kit which is used when dentists travel, particularly to third world countries. This could be invaluable for Medical Santo and something we could maybe contribute to!






