Rees Wilson will be bringing the message this Sunday. We will continue with the Holy Spirit series.





The Raise the Roof appeal was initiated at the last AGM to raise funds to address urgent repairs needed to the roof of the church and back hall, and to rectify water damage to internal ceilings and walls. This appeal has run for four weeks finishing last Sunday.

The generosity of our church family has been overwhelming, and the Church Leadership would like to express a very BIG thank you to all those who have contributed to this appeal, in response to God's prompting. We have achieved our goal, and some!! The total donation amounted to \$41,105 which covers all the repairs required for the church buildings with some also available for work needed at the manse. The roof repairs are now complete (new valleys, new lead flashing, repointing of the ridge capping, replacement of broken tiles on the church roof; and new plumbing, guttering, and downpipes on the back hall) and waiting to be tested. The internal work will commence soon. Again, we express our gratitude for your generous gifts allowing us to continue to look after the resource God has provided for now and the future.

HOW TO PACK SICESON

Remember that your shoebox gift will be an expression of God's love to a child. It may be the only gift the child receives. So plan to pack quality items that will last. Be sure to make them **FUN**, adding a "wow" item and new toys a child will love; **FULL**, with no empty space; and **PERSONALISED**, so that each is unique, prayed over, and includes a note of encouragement.

SHOEBOX: Start with a regular sized shoebox the approximate size of an A4 page or order preprinted shoeboxes online.

GIFTS: Choose a boy or girl and age group (2–4, 5–9, or 10–14) and fill your shoebox with fun toys, clothing, hygiene items, and school supplies. Include a "wow" item such as a doll, soccer ball with pump, or stuffed animal; then personalise your gift by including a note and photo.
